Kevin T. Frenz, Ph.D., received his doctoral degree in higher education from Florida State University in 1991. He currently manages the tobacco prevention and control program for the Florida Department of Health in Leon County. The program includes CDC recommended youth and young adult tobacco prevention education through Students Working Against Tobacco (SWAT), local colleges, linkage of employers and housing property managers/owners to tobacco policies, connecting tobacco users to free cessation resources, and general tobacco prevention, health effects and cessation education. He is also responsible for providing support to the Tobacco Free Leon partnership, which includes members of the community from universities, K-12 schools, health care organizations, youth, community members and other community organizations.
